Better Together!

When planning your garden, keep in mind that there are many plants that thrive when planted with compatible plants!

Companion Planting Benefits

- Boosts growth
- Provides shelter (shade)
- Provides support
- Improves soil
- Attracts beneficial insects.

Now is the time to start your seeds:

- Seeds to start indoors: Broccoli
 (sprouting varieties), cabbage, kale,
 lettuces, cosmos, zinnia, marigolds,
 and nicotiana.
- Seeds to direct sow: Beets, carrots, cilantro, lettuces, peas, parsnips, purslane (vigorous self-sower!), radish, and spinach. Be sure to remove some of your mulch layer and sow densely for success.



Tomato Friends

- Asparagus, Basil, Beans, Carrots, Celery, Leaf Lettuce, Onions, Parsley, Peppers, Root Vegetables, and Spinach
- · Borage, Marigolds
- Foes: Beets, Broccoli, Cabbage, Corn, Dill, Fennel, and Rosemary

Cucumber Friends

- Beans, Celery, Corn, Dill, Lettuce, Peas, and Radish
- Marigolds, Nasturtium
- Foes: Aromatic herbs (Sage)
