Dear Redford Township Community,

On August 2nd, Redford Township voters went to the polls to decide the future of the library. We are excited and gratified by the results. The measure to continue funding the library was passed with over 68 percent of the vote!

The support results in a slight decrease in mills levied by the library, compared to 2021, and the secured funding allows the library to move forward with renovations. Renovations include; completing the second floor of the library where 18,000 sq. ft. of space has remained unfinished since the library was built in 2004, creating new interactive spaces for kids, adding more study rooms for all ages, an expanded teen space, and more.

Planning is already underway as we look to begin construction in the fall of 2023. More updates will be provided but you can track our progress at **rtdl.org/projects** or by following us on social media. We thank you for showing up at the polls so that the library can continue to inspire ideas, enrich lives, and create community.
