Note from the Director, Garrett Hungerford



Dear Redford Township Community,

Fall is right around the corner, and the library is gearing up for renovations that will start in September. Renovations include: completing the second floor of the library where 18,000 sq. ft. of space has remained unfinished since the library was built in 2004, creating new interactive spaces for kids, adding more study rooms for all ages, an expanded teen space, and more. The entirety of the project will be split into three phases. To start, we will be closing off access to the second floor of the library while our unfinished area is transformed into a new children's space. In later phases, we will have portions of the first floor closed to the public while additional renovations take place. During all phases of construction, the library will continue to maintain regular hours. Construction is scheduled to be complete by next summer and you can track our progress at **rtdl.org/projects** or by following us on social media.

While we are eagerly anticipating the next chapter of the library building, I encourage everyone to take a look at our most recent impact report. Last fiscal year, we circulated close to a quarter of a million items, launched additional services like Kanopy and ComicsPlus, grew our homebound delivery service, and added over 14,000 new physical items to our collection. We thank-you for your continued support as we inspire ideas, enrich lives, and create community.
